PREFACE

The Directorate of Cashew Research, Puttur (Karnataka) is a unit under Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR), New Delhi established in 2009. It is an apex institute in the country to take up research and extension work on cashew. For development of location and situation specific varieties and technologies, All India Coordinated Research Project on Cashew is also under operation at 14 centers located in Karnataka, Kerala, Maharashtra and Gujarat in the West coast; Andhra Pradesh, Orissa, Tamil Nadu, and West Bengal in the East coast and in Chhattisgarh and Jharkhand in non-traditional cashew growing area besides sporadic cultivation in NEH region. The mandate of the Directorate is as follows:

- To undertake strategic, basic and applied research for enhancing productivity, quality, processing efficiency and value addition of cashew.
- To serve as a national repository of genetic resources and scientific information on cashew.
- To coordinate All India Coordinated Research Project on Cashew for addressing location and region specific problems.
- To promote capacity building through transfer of technology and consultancy services to stakeholders.

Cashew is an important horticultural crop of our country with high demand in national and international markets. However, productivity is low. This is due to various factors viz., large area under old and senile plantation, mostly seedling in origin, grown on degraded lands, improper management etc. Farmers are not well aware of latest production technologies. Updating of knowledge and skill on cashew production and processing technologies are essentially required by officials of state development agencies, extension workers and farmers. This necessitates capacity building of all those involved in cashew cultivation. The detail of various training programmes along with nomination form is given in this training schedule.

I wish that the research and developmental personnel and farmers from different states of the country would effectively utilize the facilities/services offered by this Directorate for the growth and development of the cashew in the country.

1. SOFTWOOD GRAFTING TECHNIQUE IN CASHEW (SGTC)

Objectives : To impart skill in cashew grafting and knowledge on nursery

management techniques.

Key contents: Production and maintenance of rootstock seedlings,

maintenance of scion bank, production of scions, technique of grafting, maintenance of grafts and overall nursery

management techniques.

Methodology : Classroom lecture, skill practice in nursery, visit to private

nursery and group discussion.

Duration : Two days

Bug and Cashew Stem and Root Borer. Identification of pests, symptoms of attack and IPM techniques. Minor and

regional pests and their management.

Methodology : Classroom lecture, hands-on training in laboratory and field

demonstrations.

Duration : Two days

3. CASHEW PRODUCTION TECHNOLOGY (CPT)

practices.

Key contents : Released and recommended varieties of cashew, grafting

technique and nursery management in cashew, establishment and management of cashew orchards, training and pruning in cashew, insect pests of cashew and their management, quality and post-harvest processing of cashew, cashew apple utilization and cashewnut processing, Cashew statistics and transfer of technology in

cashew.

Methodology : Classroom lectures, visit to experimental plots, cashew

demonstration plots, private nursery, cashew processing

industry and group discussion.

Duration: Three daysSchedule: January-February

GENERAL INFORMATION

Location

DCR is located in Puttur, a town at Dakshina Kannada district of Karnataka. Puttur is well connected by road and rail. It is 50 kms from Mangalore, 210 kms from Mysore and 325 kms from Bangalore. DCR campus is located 5 km away from Puttur bus stand in a place called "Mottethadka". From Puttur bus stand hired auto service is available to DCR. The 'Kabaka Puttur' railway station (Code: KBPR) is 6 kms from DCR and has trains plying to Bangalore, Mangalore, Karwar and Kannur. The Experimental Station, Shantigodu of this Directorate is located at a distance of 13 kms from the headquarters.

Eligibility

Softwood Grafting Technique in Cashew

Cashew Production Technology

Personnel working in the middle level management in development departments, State departments of agriculture/horticulture/cashew forest development corporations with working Knowledge in English.
