

Distribution of bee hive boxes to beneficiaries and a training programme on apiculture

Under the Scheduled Caste Sub Plan of Central Government, Distribution of bee hive boxes and a training programme on apiculture was organized by ICAR-Directorate of Cashew Research, Puttur in collaboration with KVK, Mangaluru on 23.01.2020 at Hatyadka village, Belthangadi Taluk. The program was inaugurated by the Chief Guest Mrs. Divya Jyoti, President of Belthangady Taluk Panchayat. Dr. M.G. Nayak, Director, Dr. Eradasappa, E, Cashew Breeder and In-charge Extension Officer, Directorate of CaShew Research, Puttur, Dr. Mallikarjuna, Soil Scientist, Agriculture Science Center, Mangalore, Sri Dharmaraja A., Vice President, Arasinamakki Grama Panchayat were present.
