

One-day Training cum demonstration on cashew processing organised for farmers of Kasaragod

A training cum demonstration programme on cashew processing was organised for 5 farmers from Badiadka panchayat of Kasaragod on 30th July 2022. The training programme was organised in collaboration with the Badiadka Krishi Bhavan, Kasaragod. The training session was handled by Dr. D Balasubramanian, Principal Scientist (AS & PE) and who is also heading the Agribusiness Incubation Centre of ICAR-DCR, Puttur. The training commenced with a theory class, in which the basic aspects of cashew processing and the steps involved was explained to the farmers. Following this, the participants were acquainted with machineries required for cashew processing. Shelling of raw cashew nuts with the hand-cum-pedal operated shelling machine and peeling were demonstrated to the participants, which were followed by hands on training session on shelling and peeling by them. Dr. Aswathy Chandrakumar, Scientist (Agrl. Extension) convened the one-day training cum demonstration on cashew processing. The farmers opined that the training was very useful and the hands-on training session helped them to understand the process of shelling and peeling in a better way.
